Cat Care Assistant

Disinfection and sanitation is of the utmost importance in keeping the cat areas free from potential viral threats. As a Cat Care Assistant you will help to clean, organize, feed, and socialize the animals and ensure the welfare and comfort needs of our feline friends are being met.

Skills/Experience:

- · Comfortable working with cats of all breeds and sizes
- · Able to follow safety protocols for scared or aggressive cats
- · Comfortable with direct contact with dirty litter boxes and cleaning agents, as well as exposure to feces, urine, vomit, mucus, saliva, and possibly blood
- · Able to tolerate cat fur, dander, and possible · Disinfect used cat carriers and bites and scratches
- · Understanding of English and able to follow both verbal and written directions. Exhibit a willingness to learn
- · Able to lift 15 lbs
- · Able to bend, squat and twist to clean and stand for 2 hours while working directly with cats
- · 18 years old or older
- · Able to work in a team environment and support and communicate professionally and politely with fellow volunteers and the public
- · Able to handle redirection and constructive criticism without responding with negativity · Adhere to the QAS Code of
- · Able to work with limited supervision

Responsibilities:

- · Scoop and refill litter boxes
- · Remove bedding and replace with fresh, as needed
- · Exchange all existing food and water bowls with clean bowls
- · Check kennel cards for special diet requirements
- litter boxes
- · Groom, play with and socialize cats
- · Observe general cat behavior and make note of important changes via logs
- · Sweep and/or mop floors. Do laundry. Empty trashcans
